Call for project proposals - SOFT projects

SOFT projects do not include an infrastructure component OR their infrastructure component is of less than 1 million EUR.

SOFT projects may be funded under the following priorities:

Priority 1.1 Institutional cooperation in the educational field for increasing access to education and quality of education
Financial allocation: EUR 2 100 000
EU contribution at project level ≥ EUR 50 000, ≤ EUR 300 000



Priority 1.2 Promotion and support for research and innovation
Financial allocation: EUR 1 500 000
EU contribution at project level ≥ EUR 50 000, ≤ EUR 300 000



Priority 2.1 Preservation and promotion of the cultural and historical heritage
Financial allocation: EUR 6 000 000
EU contribution at project level ≥ EUR 50 000, ≤ EUR 1 000 000



Priority 3.1 - Development of cross border transport infrastructure and ICT tools
Financial allocation: EUR 2 100 000
EU contribution at project level ≥ EUR 50 000, ≤ EUR 100 000



Priority 4.1 - Support to the development of health services and access to health
Financial allocation: EUR 1 200 000
EU contribution at project level ≥ EUR 50 000, ≤ EUR 300 000



Priority 4.2 - Support to joint activities for the prevention of natural and man-made disasters as well as joint actions during emergency situations
Financial allocation: EUR 2 700 000
EU contribution at project level ≥ EUR 50 000, ≤ EUR 500 000



Priority 4.3 - Prevention and fight against organised crime and police cooperation
Financial allocation: EUR 1 400 000
EU contribution at project level ≥ EUR 50 000, ≤ EUR 100 000

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Call for project proposals - HARD projects

HARD projects have an infrastructure component of at least 1 million EUR and may be funded within one of the following three priorities:

Priority 3.1 - Development of cross border transport infrastructure and ICT tools
Financial allocation: EUR 10 000 000
EU contribution at project level ≤ EUR 2 000 000 euro



Priority 4.1 - Support to the development of health services and access to health
Financial allocation: EUR 5 200 000
EU contribution at project level ≤ EUR 1 300 000



Priority 4.3 - Prevention and fight against organised crime and police cooperation
Financial allocation: EUR 3 900 000
EU contribution at project level ≤ EUR 1 300 000 euro
